

## 2022 American Red Cross Waterfront Certification Course

Pre-requites: September 7 – October 6 Course dates: October 6 & 7

- 1. Must already have a valid American Red Cross Lifeguard certification.
- 2. For pre-requisites, you must be able to:
  - -Swim 300 meters non-stop using rescue strokes (freestyle, breaststroke, sidestroke)
  - -Tread water for 2 minutes
  - Retrieve life size mannequin from 10-15 FT of water.
  - -Demonstrate CPR/AED usage
- 3. Pre-requisites will be held from September 7 to October 6. Monday, Wednesday Friday from 11 a.m. 5 p.m.
- 4. \$75.00 for Active Duty Service Members and \$100 for Civilians
- 5. Course is approximately 16 hours total. (2-Day course)
- 6. **Day 1:** Thursday, October 6; 9 a.m. 5 p.m. *Richardson Pool, Schofield Barracks.* 
  - **Day 2:** Friday, October 7; 9 a.m. 5 p.m. *Pililaau Army Recreation Center (PARC), Waianae.*
- 7. All Participants must attend both days to receive the certification.

Participants should have their own snorkel, dive mask, and fins.

This is not an Ocean Front certification.
