

Instructions for registering your family for Summer Reading Program

ONLINE REGISTRATION BEGINS JUNE 3

1. Go to <https://ftshafterlibrary.beanstack.org> or <https://sgtyanolibrary.beanstack.org>
2. Scroll down until you see the options to register for beanstack. Click on "Register an Individual or Family."

3. It will bring you to a screen that asks you who you would like to register. Begin by registering yourself, then you can participate as well as the other members of the family. Select "I am registering myself."

4. The next screen asks for information about the person being registered. Fill out the information and then select next.

5. The system will then ask if you want to register another participant in your family.

6. If you have selected “I am an adult registering a child,” the site will ask for basic information on the child being registered: first name, last name, and age. After you’ve entered the information, select “Next.”

7. Repeat the steps until you have registered all family members. Once done, the system will tell you “Great! You are all setup.” You will then be prompted to continue to your reading log. You are now ready to get credit for the minutes you’ve read.
