

Driver Ed. 101

Hawaii State law requires all persons under the age of 18 years to take and pass a licensed and certified Drivers Educational Program. They must present student completion certificates in both classroom and behind-the-wheel training from a state licensed and certified instructor prior to scheduling a road test. The program consists of 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel driving instruction with a state certified instructor. Each student must also complete 50 hours (40 daytime hours and 10 night hours) with a parent/guardian or licensed driver over the age of 21 years old. At Driver's Ed 101, all instructors are licensed with the State of Hawaii to teach both classroom and behind-the-wheel. Students will learn highway and freeway driving, safe lane changes, proper use of mirror, how to navigate intersections, parking and much more. Classes are held off post at 94-1210 Waipio Uka St, Waipahu Community Baptist Church.

Enroll for courses through Child Youth and School Services. Course fee \$370.00.

First Day of each session registration is 4:45 to 5:00pm with a **mandatory** parent/student orientation from 5:00-5:30pm. Class the first night is 5:30-7:30pm. All other classes are 5:00-7:30pm Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Teens must have a learners permit prior to behind the wheel driving and be a member of Child Youth and school services to enroll in this class.

All Instructors are certified with the State of Hawaii DOT.
