PAINT YOUR FAVORITE PET REALISTIC

Saturdays-December 1st, 8th, 15th and 22nd) 2:00pm- 4:00pm

A 4-week series of adult classes. You must be 13 and up. The class would be held on December (1st, 8th, 15th, and 22nd) each class is two hours per week every Saturday from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The class would be sold as a 4-class package for \$80 Supplies and instruction included. The student needs to register ahead of time and make sure to send an email with their fur baby's face one month prior (see example attachments) that way the instructor would have enough time to make a copy of their pet and have it the right size for the canvas. If the student pays for the class and doesn't send the picture ahead of time they would lose their spot and automatically be put on a waiting list for the next open class. (Students need to bring a 4X6 print of their pet or a picture on their phones or tablets for reference).

During the class, students will learn the basics about acrylic paints, how to set up their workstation, tools required, paint brushes (flat, round, fan, bright, detail, angular), the color wheel (primary, secondary and intermediate) we discuss about the basics of Value (Refers to the visible lightness or darkness of a color) and learn how to paint your pet's eyes and nose. Also, they will learn how to transfer their favorite pet to the 8x10 canvas.

First week:

During this first class, we will do a short review about acrylic paints, how to set up their workplace, tools required, paint brushes (flat, round, fan, bright, detail, angular), the color wheel (primary, secondary and intermediate) and also, they will learn how to transfer their favorite pet to their canvas and pick the color that works best for their background. If we have time we will start painting the background. The instructor will provide step by step instructions.

<u>Second week:</u> We will keep working on the background and the color base for the pet (the students need a 4X6 picture of their pet or a picture on their phone or tablet, they will need it for reference). We will discuss about Value (Refers to the visible lightness or darkness of a color) and they will learn how to paint their pet's eyes and nose.15 minutes before the class ends the student will clean their workstations.

Third week:

In this class, each student should have their canvas and we will be working on adding the different value to the painting and they will learn how to do fur and strokes that work better with their pet's painting. (The students need a 4X6 picture of their pet or a picture on their phone or tablet, they will need it for reference). 15 minutes before the class ends, the students will clean up their station and we will discuss and look at everybody's work.

Fourth week:

In this last class, the students will get their supplies and set up their workstations. They will work on finishing details of the fur, eyes and more. Instructor will go around answering any questions.
