PICNIC SPACE PERMIT
2023 Independence Day Celebration 01 July 2023

The following conditions apply when reserving picnic space on Weyand Field. Please initial on lines #1-9 to indicate you have read, understand and will abide by the following requirements.

___ 1. Each picnic space is 20 feet wide and 25 feet long. There is a limit of one (1) picnic space per customer. The space may have an orange cone nailed into the ground to indicate location of water sprinklers. **PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THESE CONES.**

___ 2. This reservation is authorized from 07:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on July 1, 2023. Spaces must be set up and vehicles must exit the venue no later than 10:00 a.m. You may set up your space on June, 30 2023 **at your own risk.** This Picnic Space Permit must be shown to picnic site staff upon entry and posted on your tent at all times throughout the entirety of the event. This permit will allow you temporary access to the field. Vehicles are NOT allowed on the field at any time.

___ 3. A picnic space may be used for setting up tents, canopies and/or umbrellas. These coverings will not go outside the designated space. Safety covers must be used over stakes driven into the ground. Please be cautious when driving stakes into the ground to avoid puncturing a water line. Picnic spaces are allowed to keep tents up throughout the entirety of the event.

___ 4. Barbecue grills may be used. Hot coals will NOT be placed in public trash receptacles and must be removed by customer once cool. Gas grills may be used in the authorized space until 7:00 p.m. due to public safety. **DO NOT COOK UNDER ANY TENTS, CANOPIES OR UMBRELLAS.** The grill shall be set-up as far away from the tents as possible. Please secure cooking knives when not in use.

___ 5. You are **required** to have a class B or ABC fire extinguisher onsite at all times at each picnic space.

___ 6. Prohibited items include: glass, weapons of any kind, fireworks, sparklers, backpacks, briefcases, luggage, duffel bags, skateboards, hover boards, rollerblades, scooters, bicycles, noise making devices, illegal substances, laser pointers, drones and offensive or profane messages or images on signs and clothing. Smoking is prohibited.

___ 7. The sale of items is NOT AUTHORIZED (including non-profit organizations). Items include t-shirts, food and souvenirs of any kind. Banners with business names are NOT ALLOWED. If you are caught selling any items, you will be asked to leave the premises.

___ 8. Pets and/or emotional support animals are NOT permitted at the event, to include the picnic sites (service animals are permitted)

___ 9. Spaces need to be left clean. All trash must be removed and thrown in the dumpsters before leaving the premises.

___ 10. All personnel will be required to leave the venue during security sweep at 10:00 a.m. and re-enter through an Entry Access Point after the security sweep is completed (approx. 11:00 a.m.).
