Class Descriptions

LEADER/CO-LEADER:

This training is to identify the SFRG's role and gain a better understanding of the mission essential activities. Learn the SFRG Leader role by identifying methods of communication with SFRG membership, recognize non-mission essential activities, resources, and how to solve problems at the lowest level

INFORMAL FUND CUSTODIAN:

This training is required for all current and incoming SFRG Fund Custodians. The training provides an overview of Army regulations governing management of SFRG informal funds and fundraising. Suggested training for SFRG leaders, Commanders, and Fundraising Coordinators.

KEY CONTACT:

This training provides Key Contacts with an overview of their role and responsibilities as well as how to handle crisis phone calls. Required training for all Key Contacts. This course includes tips and techniques for executing the role as well as practical exercises and scenarios.

COMMAND FAMILY READINESS REPRESENTATIVE (CFRR):

This training includes topics on understanding your role, resources for success and practical training in acting as extension of the unit. In this role, CFRRs act as an extension in providing official, accurate and command info in addition to knowing available resources and solving problems.

FAMILY READINESS ADVISOR:

This training is designed to be a foundational course on SFRG. The training covers how SFRG can assist commanders in meeting their mission while integrating all players into the SFRG. It provides basic information on the different roles within the SFRG.

COMMAND TEAMS:

This training targets company commanders, but is also informative for brigade & battalion commanders, 1SGs, and CSMs. This training goes over the roles and responsibilities of the command team and how to execute the SFRG mission.
