PURPOSE:

To design and construct a cardboard boat that can carry a crew of a captain and mates (Minimum 1 Person, Maximum of 3 crew members). It will need to be able to stay afloat for approximately 50 meters (around/through the pool obstacle course).

ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL WEAR THE PFDS PROVIDED BY THE FACILITY AT ALL TIMES.

BOAT REQUIREMENTS:

- All boats must be built before the event and will undergo an inspection at check-in to avoid disqualification. *(Teams must also include a mast no taller than 4 feet high)*
- Your boat, including any oars or paddles, must be constructed using only corrugated cardboard, duct tape, and plastic bottles or containers.
- The hull cannot be wrapped or covered with tape, wax, or crayons. Instead, waterproof the vessel by taping the bottom seams from the inside only.
- Prohibited materials include wax-based cardboard and enamel paints, as well as any other substance that could bleed into the pool.
- Any decorations you add must also serve a functional purpose by aiding in the boat's flotation.
