Employment Readiness Program (ERP), 371 Brannon Road, Bldg. 663, SB

Looking for a job? Want to change careers? Employment Readiness provides assistance in acquiring skills, networks, and resources needed to participate in the workforce and develop a career/work plan.

Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP)

Do you have an Exceptional Family Member? Do you know of resources available? EFMP representatives are ready to assist with advocacy services, resources, housing, education and child services for special needs Family members.

Family Advocacy Program: New Parent Support Program (FAP: NPSP)

Expecting a new baby? Already have a small child? Don't have transportation or can't get out of the house with small children to care for? NPSP can come to you. The New Parent Support Program is a team of nurses and social workers who provide parenting support and education to parents who are expecting or have children in the 0-3 years old range.

Family Advocacy Program: Prevention, Education & Outreach (FAP-Ed)

In addition to mandated troop trainings and command briefings, FAP-Ed provides free Play Mornings and Toon Time Matinees as well as face-to-face and voluntary classes in Stress, Anger, and Couples Communication. FAP-Ed also offers a variety of parenting classes such as Newborn Care Class, Scream Free Parenting, 123 Magic and Parenting 101. FAP-Ed also provides outreach tables and resources at Soldier & Family Readiness Group (SFRG) and Steering Committee Meetings at a units request.

Family Advocacy Program: Victim Advocacy (FAP: VA)

If you are a victim of spouse abuse, you have choices. Victim Advocates are available to assist and support victims' autonomy by empowering them to make the informed decisions relevant to their safety and welfare. To contact a victim advocate dial 808-624-SAFE.

Financial Readiness Program (FRP)

Build your Financial Resilience. One on One Financial Counseling to include budget, credit report, repair, investments and TSP, identity theft plus more. Classes offered are: Financial Resilience Series consisting of Money Management; Basics of Budgeting; Your Credit Report and Score; Investing and TSP, plus Home Buying; Car Buying; Pre-Post Deployment Financial Planning.

Mobilization, Deployment & Stability Support Operations (MD&SSO)

Classes, Interactive Workshops, Reintegration Workshops and Support Services are available to assist Soldiers and Family members through the readiness process. Various training opportunities are also available to provide a comprehensive understanding of the roles, structure and functions of the Rear Detachment Command and Soldier & Family Readiness Groups (SFRGs).

Relocation Readiness Program (RRP)

Just moved, looking for community resources, or need basic kitchen items until your household goods arrive? Relocation Readiness Program provides a Community Readiness Expo that integrates Newcomers with Military and Community resources. Services include the lending closet with basic kitchen items available for incoming or outgoing Soldiers and their Families living on or off post, Immigration application referral, Sponsorship training, Spouse Sponsorship training, monthly cultural classes and Relocation Planning.

Survivor Outreach Services (SOS), 371 Brannon Road, Bldg. 663, SB

In partnership with the Casualty Assistance Center to provide long term follow-up care for Families who have suffered the loss of their Service Member. SOS is here for as long as the Family needs.
